



SCHOOL SPONSORSHIP PROGRAM – GUIDELINES

Peavine Baptist Church believes that one of the most meaningful ways we can live out the Gospel is by serving those around us — especially in our local schools. Our School Sponsorship Program exists to create real, tangible opportunities for our church to make an impact for Christ in the lives of students, teachers, and school communities.

By meeting practical needs and building genuine relationships with our schools, we open doors for the love of Jesus to be seen and felt in places where it matters most. Every sponsorship is an investment in the Kingdom and a chance to let our light shine in the community.

ELIGIBILITY

- The school must be a public school located within a 20-mile radius of our Rock Spring Campus.
- Requests must be submitted by an authorized school staff member (teacher, counselor, administrator, etc.).

OUR PURPOSE

The goal of the School Sponsorship Program is to make a meaningful impact for the Gospel in the schools we serve. We want our schools to know that Peavine Baptist Church is a partner they can count on — and more importantly, that the love of Christ is behind every act of generosity.

Rather than limiting our support to specific categories, we consider each request on its own merits. If there is a legitimate need and an opportunity for our church to serve, we want to be part of it. Sponsorships may include, but are not limited to, support for school events, student needs, staff encouragement, and other initiatives that allow us to demonstrate the love of Christ in a practical way.

Every request is an opportunity for us to show up, serve well, and point people to Jesus.

HOW TO APPLY

All sponsorship requests must include a completed School Sponsorship Request Form, available for download from our website. Completed forms should be submitted via the website.

REVIEW PROCESS

1. All requests are reviewed by a sponsorship committee on a case-by-case basis.
2. Submitting a request does not guarantee approval.
3. The committee reserves the right to approve, modify, or decline any request based on available resources and alignment with our mission.
4. Applicants will be notified of the decision within a reasonable timeframe after submission.

IMPORTANT DEADLINES

- All requests must be submitted at least 30 days prior to the date the sponsorship is needed.
- Late submissions may not be considered.

BUDGET AND FUNDING

Each budgetary year, Peavine Baptist Church sets aside a designated amount for school sponsorships. We are glad to help as many schools as we can, but once those funds are exhausted, sponsorships will not be available again until the following year.

GENERAL POLICIES

- Sponsorships are intended to benefit students and school communities directly.
- Peavine Baptist Church may purchase items directly on behalf of the school when requested.
- Repeated or ongoing partnerships are welcome, but each request must be submitted and approved individually.

PUBLICITY AND USE OF PHOTOS

As good stewards of the resources entrusted to us by our church family, it is important that we are able to share with our members how their contributions are being used to serve the community. For this reason:

- Recipients are asked to provide photos and a brief written description of how the sponsorship was used.
- Peavine Baptist Church reserves the right to use any photos, descriptions, and information provided in connection with a sponsorship for publicity and communication purposes across all mediums, including but not limited to printed materials, social media, the church website, video, email communications, and displays within the church.
- If a sponsorship recipient requires that the support remain confidential, this must be requested at the time the sponsorship form is submitted. Confidentiality requests will require further discussion with the sponsorship committee, as our ability to share the impact of these partnerships with our members is a vital part of this program.
